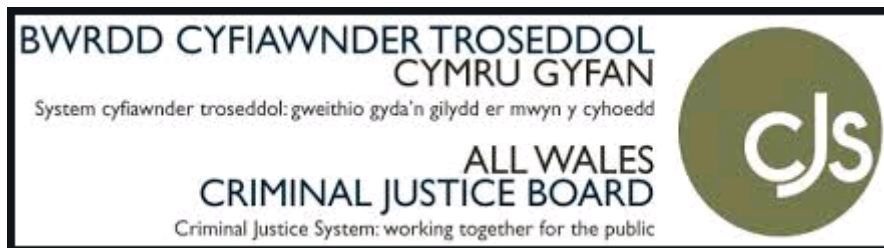

#### **Criminal Justice in Wales Board Pledge on Race Equality**
